2. WAXING AND CLEANING - to be completed in water

- Wash & brush scrub deck
- Clean, compound & wax smooth surface areas on deck and cabin houses
- Clean, compound & wax hull-sides

3. GENERAL COMMISSIONING

- Check and fill fluid levels (oil, antifreeze, power steering, trim/tilt, lube oil, etc.)
- Start engine & check for fuel or cooling system leaks
- Purge winter antifreeze from fresh water system and fill tanks (reconnect/fill hot water heater if applicable)
- Check expiration date of flares/distress signals & replace if needed – They are located _____
- Inspect fire extinguishers – Advise if service is needed or are expired – They are located _____
- Test & visually inspect bilge pumps
- Test navigation lights and bilge blower
- Charge batteries
- Inspect for anything else noticed that may need attention and will advise owner

4. ENGINE MAINTENANCE

- Change fuel filters & water separators replace oil & filters
- Replace spark plugs replace air filter (or clean spark arrester)

5. ELECTRICAL Inspection

___ Check AC inlet and cord for corrosion or heat damage

___ Open electrical panel and check for signs of corrosion or heat damage.

___ Advise if any service seems necessary

6. Ground fault test

___ Test for electrical current entering the water or electrical current returning on the safety ground circuits.

Failing this test could mean that your underwater running gear and thru hull fittings may corrode due to electrolysis

Failing this test could mean that you will not be able to plug your boat into an increasing number of marinas with GFI detection, such as Provincetown marina and some Constitution marina slips.

7. J&B UNDERWATER SERVICES

___ Clean Hull and Replace Zincs, \$3.75/ft. Sailboats, \$4.25/ft. powerboats plus materials, plus \$13 labor per zinc installed
Add \$.50/ft. for boats 50-70ft. Boats with extremely fouled hulls are subject to increase.
